START AND FINISH. The Saturday start & Sunday finish will be between the mast of the Race Committee boat or orange flag & the WNATR "N" Buoy. (42° 02.8' N 83° 06.5' W) If the "N" Buoy has been removed for the season; an orange tetrahedron buoy will be placed in the approximate location. If a protection mark is present, it must be honored.

Saturday's finish and Sunday's starting line will be between the Race Committee on shore in front of the pavilion and the East point of the outer break wall.

COURSE. This is a fixed 23 mile mark course to be sailed as follows:

JAM and Spinnaker:

On Saturday:

From the Start line at WSSC "N" Mark; proceed towards Colchester and round Em2 buoy (leave to port), then proceed to the finish line at Leamington

On Sunday:

From the Start line at Learnington; proceed towards Colchester and round Em2 buoy (leave to starboard), then proceed to the finish line at WSSC "N" Mark
